He has also been busy doing electrical contracting work this month to provide for his family.

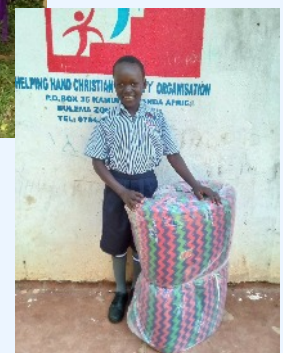
Seeds have been purchased, which will be planted and produce distributed amongst the elderly in the community, once the crops are harvested.
